This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students achieving a C standard or higher in English and Mathematics
- Increase the percentage of students achieving at or above year level PM benchmarks in Reading
- Increase the percentage of students in years 3 and 5 achieving the National Minimum Standard (NAPLAN) in Reading
- Increased percentage of Year 3 and 5 students achieving in the Upper Two Bands in Reading
- Increase attendance to at or above 92% for the whole school

Our initiatives include


- Develop teacher knowledge and understanding of the P-10 Australian Curriculum English content descriptions and achievement standards by designing and supporting processes for robust pre- and post-moderation
- Develop monitoring and review processes to ensure the intent and rigour of the Australian Curriculum are enacted in all classrooms
- Refine the school pedagogical framework and embed it as the shared language of teaching and learning
- Provide focused and intensive teaching targeted at 'C' students in order to improve the quality of their demonstrations of learning against the relevant year-level achievement standard.
- Embed and monitor agreed strategies for the teaching of reading to ensure consistency across the school
