- Increase the percentage of students in years 3 and 5 achieving the national minimum standard in reading
- Increased percentage of year 3 and 5 students achieving in the upper two bands in reading

Our initiatives include


- Refine teacher knowledge and understanding of the P-10 Australian Curriculum English content descriptions and achievement standards by designing and supporting processes for robust pre- and post-moderation including planning for differentiation and engagement of all students.
- Monitor processes to ensure the intent and rigour of the Australian Curriculum are enacted in all classrooms
- Develop high expectations for students with a disability through increased inclusion across the school
- Develop high yield pedagogical practices across the school
- Enable teachers to monitor student learning and provide timely and actionable feedback to students in order to improve the quality of their demonstrations of learning against the relevant year-level achievement standard
- Monitor agreed strategies for the teaching of reading to ensure consistency and improved practice across the school

Using I4S funding to employ additional teacher to maximise student engagement and achievement with a focus on pedagogy	\$85,000
Using I4S funding to increase Deputy Principal position from 0.5 FTE to 1.0 FTE with a focus on monitoring and improving teaching and learning through coaching	\$70,356
Using I4S funding to employ additional Teacher to enable the use of Year level co-ordinators with a focus on pedagogy and student achievement	\$85,000
Using I4S funding to purchase additional speech language support	\$16,500
Using I4S and school funding to employ a Pasifika Success teacher aide to monitor, assist and advocate for the academic achievement of students	\$30,000
