Each school review generates a number of key improvement strategies to inform continuous improvement in all state schools. The next steps are...

- ➔ Develop instructional and relational leadership capabilities of the leadership team, through coaching and mentoring, building their effectiveness to support the whole-school enactment of key priority areas.
- ➔ Build the capability of leaders and teachers to plan, teach and assess the Australian Curriculum learning areas, general capabilities and cross-curriculum priorities, ensuring learning is engaging, accessible and challenging.
- ➔ Collaboratively develop and implement a plan to build the collegial culture across the school, focusing on improving communication, consistency and collaboration between all staff.
- ➔ Reinvigorate and consistently implement Tier 1 Positive Behaviour for Learning processes, proactively accessing regional support, to build staff capability, facilitate professional development, enhance staff self-assessment and increase teacher agency to positively impact student behaviour.
- ➔ Collaboratively develop comprehensive action plans, backward mapping the annual implementation plan, including responsibilities, accountabilities, observable behaviours and timelines for all school leaders and other roles within the school.
